WHO ARE SCCAPG MEMBERS?

The Southern California Chapter of the Association of Professional Genealogists (SCCAPG) was founded for the purpose of providing a forum where local professional and interested amateur genealogists could get together to share ideas, problems, and solutions in their profession. SCCAPG supports the Association of Professional Genealogists (APG) Code of Ethics. Some members work independently; others are employed by genealogical business firms, libraries, or other organizations.

APG members offer a variety of services; most conduct research on individual families and may specialize in geographic areas, ethnic groups, time periods, or particular records. They have experience analyzing lineages, planning research strategies, and evaluating evidence.

Many members lecture, teach, publish, translate foreign records, develop genealogical software, or provide consulting services for those who prefer to do their own family research. Others research for medical projects (including family health histories) or legal cases, document historic sites, or conduct biographical and local history research for popular and academic writers.
